It is about an Erasmus+ project in which Poland, Sweden, the Netherlands and Spain come together to bring together young people and professionals in order to think new narratives.

This activity is designed so that people in different age ranges can participate: young participants, youth workers who want to acquire tools to work on migration issues with young people, workers from local organisations and people linked to the entities that cooperate to carry out this project.

This is an intercultural activity in which digital content such as podcasts, narrative stories in comic format and educational material will be created, thanks to which we will be contributing to more respectful contexts as well as reducing and curbing hate speech thanks to the new narratives on migration that we will build to transmit it in our cities, countries, at European and global level.
